**DINING PLANS (SELECT ONE):**

On behalf of the entire Dining Services staff, Chartwells is delighted to welcome you to Marywood University for the 2008-2009 academic year. We are looking forward to the exciting year ahead. We feel that we have one of the finest dining programs around with plenty of special events, innovative promotions and fun. Over the summer, we reviewed our program and made changes based on student feedback - enhancing the program to better satisfy your dining needs. Whether you are on the go, an early riser or a casual diner, we are sure our program will meet your needs.

Our meal plans have been designed to accommodate the various needs of our students. With our meal plans, you will have the option of enjoying up to an unlimited amount meals on campus each week. When you become a meal plan member, your student ID card allows you to use your meal plan at any of our dining locations - whenever and however you need. When signing up, select a meal plan based on your academic schedule, eating patterns and social life.

- **The Meal Per Week** option allows you to enjoy up to a specified number of guaranteed meals each week during the semester for which you have signed up. Meals do not carry over from week to week and 'reset' at the end of each week.
- **The Block Meal** option offers students the most flexibility as the amount of meals that you sign up for can be used throughout the semester in any manner - and carry over from week to week.

All of our meal plans can be used at our all-you-care-to-eat dining hall as well as in our Atrium and Ritazza through the meal exchange. You select the meal plan option and number of meals when you sign up. The more meals you sign up for the more you save!

- **Plan Points:** Plan Points are accepted like cash in all our dining locations. Plan Points works on the same principle as a debit card. You can use your Plan Points to purchase beverages, snacks or even a full meal in the Ritazza Café, The Atrium, and at the First Stop. Each time you make a purchase, the purchase amount is subtracted from your Plan Points Balance. Plan Points do not carry over from semester to semester, as they are part of your semester meal plan. However Pacer Points can be added to your account at the Cashier's Office and they do carry over from semester to semester, but not from year to year. Additional Pacer Points can be added to your account at any time. Please note that the Pacer Points would be in addition to any Plan Points that accompany your meal plan, please see the below plan options.

**Traditional Meal Plans**

- Open House Plan:** This plan offers students the greatest value. You can enjoy unlimited access to the main dining hall during the day and the ability to use one swipe of the card per day for late night service. This plan also includes \$100 Plan Points.
- 19 Meal Standard Plan:** This plan is designed for students who want to eat an average of three meals a day on a meal plan. You can enjoy up to 19 of 26 meals offered each week in the dining hall as well as in our retail operations through the meal exchange option. You can also use this plan during late night to be exchanged for up to \$6 value. This plan is also supplemented with \$100 in Plan Points.
- 12 Meal Plan:** This plan has the greatest flexibility. You can enjoy up to 12 of the 26 meals offered each week in the dining hall as well as in our retail operations through the meal exchange option. You can also use this plan during late night to be exchanged for up to \$6 value. This plan is also supplemented with \$100 in Plan Points.

**Block Meal Plans**

Students control when and where these meals are used. Block meals may also be used to treat friends or family to a meal in the dining hall. The plans compare in value to the 19 and 12 meal plans and should be priced accordingly. Students may also exchange a block meal in the Ritazza Café Gourmet Coffee Bar or use one per day at Late Night where they will receive a value of \$6.00. Choose from the following meal plans...

- 185 Block Meal Plan:** 185 Meals per Semester and \$100 Plan Points
- 150 Block Meal Plan:** 150 Meals per Semester and \$100 Plan Points
- 50 Block Meal Plan:** 50 Meals per Semester and \$50 Plan Points **Not available to Madonna, Regina & Loughran Hall residents**
- 25 Block Meal Plan:** 25 Meals per Semester and \$ 25 Plan Points **Not available to Madonna, Regina & Loughran Hall residents**
- No Meal Plan:** Available only to residents of the Woodland Townhouse Apartments.
